

# Responsible coaching movement





- The [Responsible Coaching Movement](#) (RCM) is a call to action for sport organizations to implement policies and processes to ensure athletes are safe. Coordinated by the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC) and the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport, it highlights three key areas:
  - Rule of Two
  - Background Screening
  - Respect and Ethics Training
- These concepts are preventative tools to protect the organization, the coach and to reduce the instances of negative sport experiences related to bullying, abuse, unethical coaching, etc.

# What does it mean for BC Alpine?



- Create a policy whereby all PSO training camps and competitions with minor athletes will require 2 adults in coaching/supervisory roles. One coach must reflect the genders of the athletes\*
- All BCST coaches and BC alpine staff and board are required to complete the Respect Group Training.
- Review and refine policies and agreements annually
- Present the plan for the coming years

- Present internal practices audit at the Summit
- Facilitate discussions at the Summit
- Facilitate club discussions on ways to implement rule of two at Summit
- Create an action plan for screening of coaches and volunteers at the club level (background screening matrix)
- Endorse the implementation of Respect in Sport Training
- Review and refine policies and agreements annually

- Produce compliance report on RCM actions
- Produce compliance report on Rule of Two
- Produce compliance report on screening
- Review ethical training requirements
- Review and refine policies and agreements annually
