

# BC ALPINE OFFICIAL'S - RULES OF ALPINE SKI RACING

---

## EXTRACT FROM BC RULES APPLICABLE TO THIS RACE

### Submission of Race Entries

All race entries must be properly submitted by the competitors club in time for the draw or entry deadline. If the entry form is not properly prepared, signed or submitted prior to the deadline, the Race Committee has the right to refuse entry.

Entries for FIS events are to be submitted by the respective Zone Alpine Coach no later than 24 hours before the draw.

NO entry will be accepted by the Race Committee unless it contains the last and first name, card number, race points for discipline, club, age group category and year of birth of each competitor.

The entry fee for each racer must either be enclosed with the entry or must be paid no later than one hour prior to the draw at which time all changes in entries must be updated. The Race Committee has the right to refuse an entry which is not accompanied by the entry fee.

### CERTIFICATION OF RACE OFFICIALS

The following are the minimum requirements for all racing programs in BC Alpine.

#### Certification of Race Officials for Downhill and Super G Events

| Referee            | Either: A coach with a minimum of Level II coach certification plus Level II Officials Certification or Divisional, National, or FIS Technical Delegate with DH/SG certification |
| Technical Delegate | Minimum if Divisional Technical Delegate with certification in DH/SG Events.   |

#### Certification of Race Officials for Technical Events

| Chief of Race       | Level II Officials Certification   |
| Start Referee       | Level II Officials Certification   |
| Finish Referee      | Level II Officials Certification   |
| Assistant Referee** | Level I or II coach  |
| Referee             | A coach with minimum of Level II coach certification plus Level II Officials Certification |
| Technical Delegate  | Minimum of Divisional Technical Delegate   |

\*\*Note: For Technical Events in BC Alpine, the position of Assistant Referee is optional
